Names of God in the Old Testament¹

Jehovah Nissi: The LORD is my Banner (Exodus 17:15)

Jehovah-Raah: The LORD is my shepherd (Psalm 23)

Jehovah Rapha: The LORD who heals (Exodus 15:26)

Jehovah Shammah: THE LORD IS THERE (Ezekiel 48:35)

Jehovah Tsidkenu: The LORD Our Righteousness (Jeremiah 23:5-6)

Jehovah Jireh: The LORD Will Provide (Genesis 22:14)

Jehovah Shalom: The LORD Is Peace (Judges 6:24)

Provide the following list to the participants for their reading and reflection.

A Comparison of Isaac and Jesus	
Isaac—the long promised, miraculously born son—was an unwilling participant in the events on Mount Moriah.	Jesus Christ—the long promised, miraculously born Son—was a willing participant in the events on Mount Calvary.
Isaac carried the wood for the sacrifice to Mount Moriah.	Jesus carried his wooden cross to Mount Calvary.
Isaac's hands and feet were bound on the altar.	Jesus' hands and feet were nailed to the cross.
Isaac was delivered.	Christ was crucified.
